### Participating artists:

MINDY FITTERMAN works in textiles, paper, paint, and stitch. Her work is inspired by nature, rhythmic geometric patterns and her love of color.

JANICE JONES is a teacher and lecturer whose work has been published in Quilter's Newsletter magazine. She has won awards in fine art exhibitions and textile art shows. Collecting natural materials strengthens her connection to her surroundings. Her sense of discovery is peaked through experience and experimentation.

MICHELE O'NEIL KINCAID has spent her life immersed in artistic endeavors, from sewing, painting, crafting, to finally becoming a quilt/fiber artist. She says my greatest inspiration is nature. "I use whatever the piece tells me: fabrics, threads, beads and color."
